2.1. *What data do we collect?*

We may collect the following data:

- Personal identification information (such as your name, email address, phone number, post code).
- Information about your business or personal lifestyle, challenges and history via questionnaires or meetings.

2.2. *How do we collect your data?*

You directly provide Us with the majority of the data we collect. We may also collect and process data when you:

2.3. How will we use your data?

2.4. How do we store your data?
